



The Organizing Committee of the 17th International Conference on General Linguistics (CILG 2027) is pleased to announce that the next edition of the conference will be held at the University of Jaén from June 16 to 18, 2027.

The University of Jaén continues thus the tradition of this biennial gathering which, since its first edition in Valencia (1994), has been held in Granada, Salamanca, Cádiz, León, Santiago de Compostela, Barcelona, Madrid, Valladolid, Zaragoza, Pamplona, Alcalá de Henares, Vigo, Sevilla, Madrid, and Alicante.

The omnipresence and central role of language in all dimensions of human life explain the complexity of linguistic studies. This complexity is reflected in the breadth and variety of disciplines that, from the perspective of General Linguistics, delve into the research of language (as a general faculty) and languages (as its specific manifestation). This conference is aimed at this broad disciplinary spectrum, aspiring to become a fruitful forum for academic discussion and exchange regarding the latest advances in the field.

The CILG 2027 will feature two plenary lectures, a round table, thematic panels, oral communications and posters, in addition to the assembly of the faculty of the General Linguistics Area. The lectures will be given by Kees Hengeveld and Milagros Fernández Pérez, respectively. In the round table, which will deal with language and discrimination, Carla Amorós Negre, Francisco García Marcos, Luisa Martín Rojo, María del Carmen Méndez Santos and Juan Carlos Moreno Cabrera will take part.

The conference will accept contributions in any of the official languages of Spain, along with English. Submissions will be grouped around the following thematic strands:
